

Directions to Hole-in-the-Wall Group Campground in Mojave National Preserve

MDLT staff will be at the Hole in the Wall Group Campground by 4:00pm on May 22nd (Saturday). The campground is located across from the Hole in the Wall campground on Black Canyon Road. The easiest access is from I-40 on Essex Road, about 100 miles east of Barstow, CA.

- 1. From Joshua Tree travel east on Hwy 62 toward Twentynine Palms**
- 2. Turn left onto Adobe Road, travel 2 miles.**
- 3. Turn right onto Amboy Road then follow the road for 46.8 miles**
- 4. Turn right at Historic Route 66 and continue for 33.5 miles**
- 5. Turn right left onto Essex Road and travel north on Essex Road past I-40**
- 6. from I-40 on Essex Road exit continue following the road north to the intersection of Black Canyon Road, 9.7 miles.**
- 7. Turn right onto Black Canyon Road and follow it north for 9.7 miles.**
- 8. Hole in the Wall Visitor Center is on the left and the entrance to the Group Campground is to the right. Turn right and follow the dirt road for about ½ mile.**

For Land Stewards traveling on the morning of May 23rd (Sunday)

Directions to the corner of Lanfair/Ivanpah Road and Cedar Canyon Road in Lanfair Area of Mojave National Preserve

- 1. Follow the above directions 1 through 5 but get onto I-40 heading east from the Essex Road entrance, travel for 6.8 miles.**
- 2. Take the Goffs Road exit and turn left at Goffs Road and continue for 10.6 miles.**
- 3. Turn left at Lanfair Road and continue for 16.3 miles.**
- 4. You are at the corner of Lanfair/Ivanpah Road and Cedar Canyon Road. There should be street signs on your left to confirm the location.**
